





HEATON MOOR GOLF CLUB TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELATING TO VISITORS AND SOCIETIES

Organisers of visiting parties are held responsible for their members and should read the conditions below before booking.

- 1. All facilities of the Heaton Moor Golf Club are available to members of visiting societies on the day.
- 2. A booking cannot be regarded as definite until the signed booking form is completed and returned with a deposit of £50, not later than two weeks after the provisional booking has been made. An acknowledgement and receipt will be sent to you. Deposits will be credited to the final account, which is payable on the day of the event to the Administrator. Please note that the package is a combined offer from the Club and the Catering Manager, therefore two separate payments will be required on the day.
- 3. The whole or part of the deposit may be refundable up to six weeks before the booked date. Cancellation after this time will result in the forfeiture of the deposit paid.
- 4. Final numbers must be advised to the Administrator at least 4 days prior to the event, detailing those requiring the full package plus any additional golfers only, or meal guests only; please advise of any special dietary requirements. You should note that if the number attending on the day is less than booked, the meals will be charged as booked eg if 20 meals are booked and only 18 attend, you will be charged for 20 meals.
- 5. Any format of play with two, three or fourball matches is allowed, with the exception of fourball strokeplay matches. A copy of your starting schedule for morning and afternoon matches should be given to the Professional on the day to enable him to monitor progress and advise Club members of first tee availability. Please allow 9 min intervals for threeball matches and 10 min intervals for fourball matches.
- All matches to commence from the first tee on the yellow markers unless directed by the Professional. Starting times must be strictly observed.
 DO NOT PLAY FROM THE FIRST TEE UNTIL THE GREEN IS CLEAR.
- 7. Heaton Moor Golf Club cannot be held responsible in any way for damage or injury to property, persons or vehicles. As part of the day package, visitors will be fully insured against such contingencies; no excess is payable. Any incidents or out of bounds shots, which may have caused damage or injury, should be investigated and details entered in the incident book in the Clubhouse.
- 8. Visitors are expected to observe the rules of golf, etiquette and dress both on the course and in the clubhouse.
