

TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELATING TO VISITING SOCIETIES

Organisers of visiting parties are held responsible for their members and should read the conditions below before booking.

1. A minimum of 12 players must attend in order to qualify for the reduced green fee rate charged to societies. If less than 12 attend you will be charged the normal green fee rate for the day.

- 2. All facilities of the Heaton Moor Golf Club are available to members of visiting societies on the day.
- 3. A booking cannot be regarded as definite until the signed booking form is completed and returned with a deposit of £100 to secure the tee times. A Further deposit of £8 per head is required if the option of a 2 or 3 course meal is required. An acknowledgement and receipt will be sent to you. Deposits will be credited to the final account, which is payable on the day of the event to the Administrator. If the Administrator is not available please pay the Professional. Please note that the package is a combined offer from the Club and the Catering Manager, therefore two separate payments may be required on the day.
- 4. The whole or part of the deposit may be refundable for the golf, up to six weeks before the booked date. Cancellation after this time will result in the forfeiture of the deposit paid. Whole or part of the deposit may be refundable for catering, up to 4 days prior to the event.
- 5. Final numbers must be advised to the Caterer at least 4 days prior to the event, detailing those requiring a) full package b) golfers not eating c) guests eating and not golfing. Please advise of any special dietary requirements. You should note that if the number attending on the day is less than booked, the meals will be charged as booked eg if 20 meals are booked and only 18 attend, you will be charged for 20 meals.
- 6. Any format of play with two, three or fourball matches is allowed, with the exception of fourball strokeplay matches. Tees are allocated at 10 minute intervals.
- All matches to commence from the first tee on the yellow markers unless directed by the Professional. Starting times must be strictly observed.
 DO NOT PLAY FROM THE FIRST TEE UNTIL THE GREEN IS CLEAR.
- 8. Heaton Moor Golf Club cannot be held responsible in any way for damage or injury to property, persons or vehicles. As part of the day package, visitors will be fully insured against such contingencies; no excess is payable. Any incidents or out of bounds shots, should be investigated and details entered on an Incident Report Form available in the Clubhouse.
- 9. Visitors are expected to observe the rules of golf, etiquette and dress code, both on the course and in the clubhouse.
