

19. Shotgun Start Competitions

Introduction

A Shotgun Start is a competition when all players tee off at the same time from different tees across the course. If 18 holes are being used and it is a four-ball competition then 72 players can be accommodated, in practice two teams are started from some tees so the number of players can be increased to up to 88 players.

When this type of competition is played the course is effectively closed from the course opening time until four and half hours after the Shotgun Start Competition tee off time.

For example, In summer when the course opens at 07.00 a Shotgun Start Competition teeing off at 09.30 would occupy the course for seven hours which is equivalent to 168 tee off times.

Given the demand for tee times running Shotgun Start Competitions significantly reduces the tee times available to members and potentially reduces visitor income.

Policy on Competitions with a Shotgun Start

Competitions with a shotgun start are not permitted between the 1st of May and 30th September.

The exceptions are Shotgun start Competitions may be organised by The President, Ladies Captain and Men's Captain on one Sunday each during this period.

Additionally, with the Board's approval up to three Charity Shotgun start Competitions may be organised during this period.

Any Shotgun Start Competition must tee off no later than 09.30

20. Hole In One Payment

A "Hole-in-One" achieved by any playing member of Heaton Moor Golf Club competing in a "recognised" golf competition at Heaton Moor Golf Club will be paid £50 by the Club to recognise and celebrate their achievement.

The "Hole-in-One" must be achieved anytime from the last Saturday in March (Men's Spring Meeting) up to and including the last Saturday in October (Men's Autumn Meeting).

A list of players achieving a "Hole-in-One" each year will be displayed in the Golf Club.

Process

A player must be playing in a "recognised" competition that they will normally have paid an entry fee to compete in. The format can be singles, pairs or a team competition played from any tee. If the format is singles the competition should have been entered via the PSi and their score input following completion of their round.

Payment for a "Hole-in-One" **will not be paid** to players who are playing "Socially" (e.g. Monday Fiddle) or completing individual Casual Rounds for handicap purposes.

On achieving a “Hole-in-One” the player must provide their completed score card (or Copy) to the Handicap and Competitions Team. The card must contain the date and name of the competition and as a minimum the gross scores achieved on all holes played and must be signed by the player and their marker.

Once verified by the Competitions and Handicap Team payment of £50 will be made from Club funds directly into the individuals bank account or credited to their bar card
